Thirteen years ago, I accepted the position of head coach for this amazing team of advocates because I firmly believed that **advocacy** is the only option for securing lasting at-scale changes for children.

Advocacy forces politics and policy to align. It is a full-body contact sport that is not for the faint of heart. The arena is competitive, requiring strategy and fierce **determination**.

The results are in for 2025. Every dollar donated to Children First generated \$130 in permanent new public **investment** in the lives of children. Our five-year winning streak generated \$2.3 billion in new recurring public spending that is **nurturing** the hearts, minds and bodies of the most important players, our children. This kind of impact takes the support of hundreds of donors and volunteers who propel us to victory.

Early next year I will be stepping down to make way for a **new** leader who can breathe even more vitality into this team. I was so fortunate to inherit a **strong** bench built by indefatigable Shelly Yanoff, one of the all-time greats.

Thanks to all our generous fans, we've grown five times stronger since then with a lineup of twenty-seven staff. THE Commonwealth Court found that the majority of Pennsylvania students attend schools that are intentionally shortchanged by state lawmakers. Our highly **MOTIVATED** team of hundreds of advocates coached every state lawmaker from our region, encouraging them to advance the ball for every student so they have a **BETTER** chance of graduating with real world skills that set them up for a lifetime of success. Our work rallied lawmakers to support a \$1 billion increase for public education, marking the second year in a row that disadvantaged students win big.

WE led an offensive strategy that scouted and built a team of rural school leaders from across the state, and youth and educators from public and charter schools in the greater Philadelphia region. These key players moved the message up the field, leading the way for this **HISTORIC** win.

LITERALLY, children's lives are on the line. Forty percent of teens report being sad, anguished, or depressed every week, and 60% of children who take their lives never saw a mental health professional before doing so. Fewer Penalties Increase Wins



WHEN it comes to giving youth a second chance, we are **LEADING** the charge to keep children out of jails by creating options for healing and restoration. Fortunately, the key players controlling the state's policy playing field get that communities are safer when youth get to re-enter the game with the **SKILLS** to regulate their behavior and make good choices.

THAT'S why we are so proud to be one of the key strategy coaches of the PA Youth Justice Alliance, a united effort of conservative and progressive organizations lining up **AMBITIOUS** plays that already are gaining traction. The Alliance worked extra innings to educate lawmakers that locking up young people keeps them out of the game for a lifetime. Now, the Alliance's playbook includes **RALLYING** lawmakers to adopt powerful new investments in diversion programs that promote accountability and rehabilitation, and keep children out of jail.

HALL OF FAME

IT was a tough season for young children in Pennsylvania. The President threatened to wipe out Head Start and some of his supporters in Pennsylvania wanted to adopt slash-and-burn cuts to the state's stellar Pre-K Counts program. It was a hard-fought game, but with our partners we **PROTECTED** our field position. The state budget impasse forced play into overtime that ended with a victory for our team as state lawmakers didn't give up any yardage on **INVESTMENTS** in pre-k or child care.

IN addition to a defensive game, a broad coalition of early childhood and business leaders blitzed and overwhelmed lawmakers with a show of force behind an **INNOVATIVE** plan to boost the pay for child care staff given the crucial role they play in developing young minds. We got very close to breaking through, but the oversized defense of the fiscal hawks blocked our win.



LEADING THE LEAGUE IN INTERCEPTIONS

LEAD paint in a child's home is the primary reason that more than 11,000 children suffer lead poisoning. We are intercepting it at its source by **RECRUITING** local governments to agree to condition licensure of rental units on an updated lead safe certification and require a **GUARANTEE** on a seller's disclosure that a residence is lead safe at the time of sale. This year, **FOUR MORE** communities joined our line-up bumping the league to 10 communities that are stopping the risk of childhood lead exposure in its tracks.

OUR OWNERS ROLL UP THEIR SLEEVES

This year, 42 parents stepped up to **CONTRIBUTE** to our victories. They completed a robust training course, completed ambitious advocacy projects, and contributed their time and community capital to get the needs of children in front of literally **EVERY** decision maker across the five-county region. Their leadership inspired others, **SWELLING** our ranks to **1,884** parents, grandparents and other supporters who pushed policymakers **TO DO MORE** to improve the lives of children.

OUR MINOR LEAGUE IS HOT

NOW in our third year of building our AAA team, 150 high school students learned the basics of the game of **ADVOCACY** and practiced making the case to state lawmakers to meet their constitutional obligation to fund public schools. Our young leaders were more than **READY** for curve balls thrown by politicians and hit it out of the park to the delight of fans and supporters from their peers in the 13 school districts who cheered them on.

A CONTENDER FOR RUSHING

PENNSYLVANIA is inching up in its ranking in adopting **FAMILY-FRIENDLY** policies. Thirteen states guarantee working parents paid time off to care for newborns or a sick family member. This year, we racked up more rushing yards than any other state as we recruited Republicans and Democrats to back the PA Family Care Act. Now, Pennsylvania is only place where paid family leave has strong, bold **BIPARTISAN** support, setting the state up to wear the championship ring once the measure is passed.
